

**MONONA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING  
MARCH 22, 2016**

The Monona County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 8:30 a.m. o'clock on Tuesday, March 22, 2016 in the boardroom of the courthouse in Onawa, Monona County, Iowa with Chairman Collison presiding. Other Supervisors present: Brady Hanson and Tom Brouillette. Supervisor Absent: None. Also present was Auditor Marilyn M. Kelley and Kelly Seward, Deputy Auditor.

Auditor Kelley presented the FY 16 Budget Amendment for the jail plumbing project. Supervisor Collison made a motion, seconded by Supervisor Brouillette to set April 12<sup>th</sup> as the date and 9:00 a.m. as the time for the FY 16 Budget Amendment Hearing and to publish such. Vote on motion: All Ayes. Motion carried.

Mike Heck of Onawa is present, along with Rhonda Murray, Jodie Nielsen, and Laura Oliver. Mr. Heck is here today to express that he is upset with an employee. The employee did send an apology and verbally apologized again to Mr. Heck today.

Environmental Health/Zoning Administrator is present to have a discussion on the septic system at Blue Haven subdivision. She discussed the past practices and work that had previously been completed.

Nuisance complaint #41 was presented by Ms. Bubke and she is requesting the Boards authorization to send a letter to the property owner. The Board directed Ms. Bubke to send a letter to the property owner.

The City of Blencoe has requested fuel assistance. It was moved by Supervisor Brouillette, seconded by Supervisor Collison to approve giving the City \$300 for fuel assistance as has been done in the past. Vote on motion: All Ayes. Motion carried.

Supervisor Hanson was in attendance at the SIMPCO Board meeting on Thursday, March 17<sup>th</sup> in Sioux City, Iowa. He shared information from the meeting with the other Supervisors. He also got to speak with Megan Weaver regarding Blencoe's lift pump station and Castana's tornado siren.

It was moved by Collison, seconded by Brouillette, to approve payment of the I.D.D.A. dues in the amount of \$100.00 and the Mutual Protection Fund dues in the amount of \$100.00 due and payable July 1, 2016 for fiscal year 2016-2017. Vote on motion: Ayes: Hanson, Collison and Brouillette. Nays: None. Motion carried. It was moved by Collison, seconded by Brouillette, to approve payment number two of the three year pledge for assisting the I.D.D.A. with legal fees on the Des Moines Waterworks Lawsuit in the amount of \$110.00. Vote on motion: Ayes: Brouillette, Collison and Hanson. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Deleta Huffman, Secondary Roads Office Manager is present for Secondary Roads business.

Motion was made by Supervisor Hanson, seconded by Supervisor Brouillette to approve the pay estimate for Project BROS-CO67(74)—8J-67 and Project BROS-CO67(75)—8J-67. Vote on motion: All Ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Supervisor Brouillette, seconded by Supervisor Hanson to approve the utility permit from WIPCO. Vote on motion: All Ayes. Motion carried.

Motion was then made by Supervisor Hanson, seconded by Supervisor Collison, accepting receipt of the Local Road Safety Plan. Vote on motion: All Ayes. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Supervisor Collison, seconded by Supervisor Brouillette to approve the minutes of March 14 and 21, 2016 as read. Vote on motion: All Ayes. Motion Carried.

Motion was made by Supervisor Collison, seconded by Supervisor Brouillette to approve claims. Vote on motion: All Ayes. Motion Carried.

It was moved by Supervisor Collison, seconded by Supervisor Hanson to hereby adjourn at the hour of 10:55 a.m. o'clock. Vote on motion: All Ayes. Motion Carried.
