**CANDIDATE FILING PERIOD FOR 2018  
PRIMARY BEGINS**

The candidate filing periods for the June 5, 2018 Primary Election begins this month.

The filing period for **County Offices** is **March 5-March 28, 2018**. Nomination papers must be received by 5:00 p.m. on the last day of the filing period at the Monona County Auditor's Office.

Candidates who are interested in running for office for the Democratic, Republican or Libertarian Party must file nomination papers to be placed on the Primary Election ballot.

Candidates who are not running with the state's political parties are not eligible to appear on the Primary Election ballot. They must file during the General Election filing periods in August.
