

ORDINANCE NO. 12

**AN ORDINANCE FORBIDDING JUMPING OR DIVING
FROM COUNTY BRIDGES**

BE IT enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Monona County, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Permitted Access Areas. No person shall jump or dive from any bridge or other like structures located on or over any county road or highway.

SECTION 2. Penalty. A person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a simple misdemeanor and subject to a maximum fine of \$100.00 or up to 30 days in jail, plus surcharge and court costs.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All ordinance or parts of ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Severability Clause. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such adjudication shall not effect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. When Effective. This ordinance shall be effective after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
